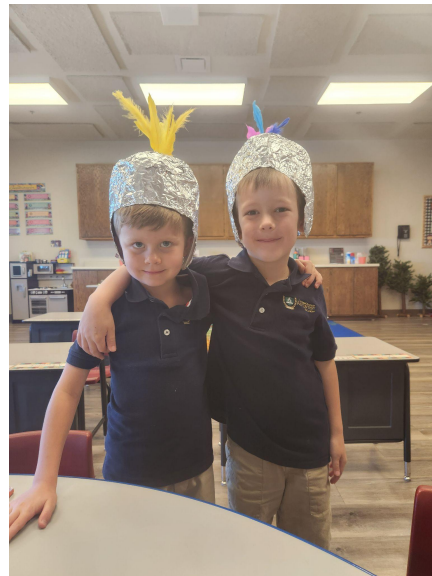

## Week 4: Learning, Learning, and more... Learning!

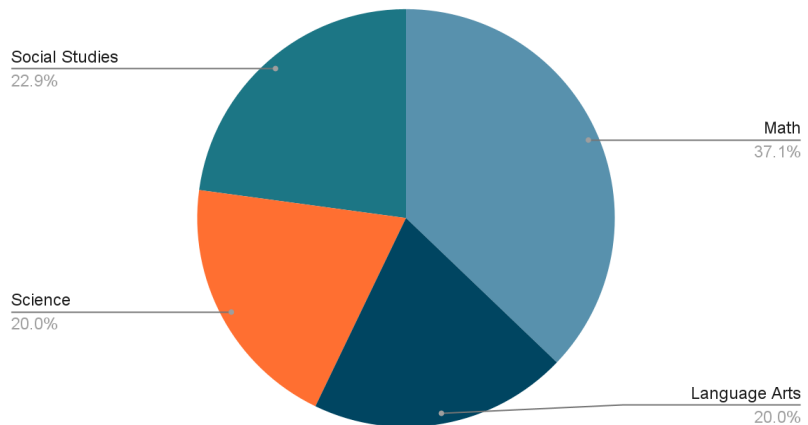


*This year, we are so excited to have our 8th-10th graders interviewing and gathering information for our newsletter! Here's what they found:*

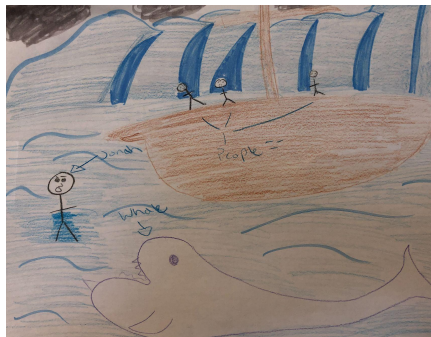
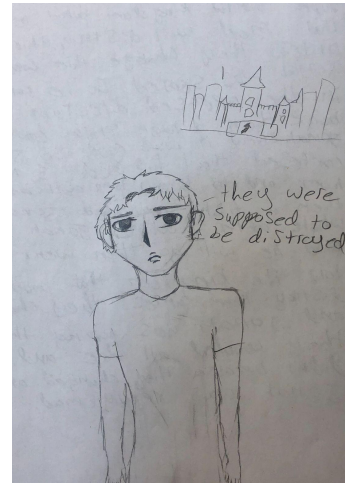
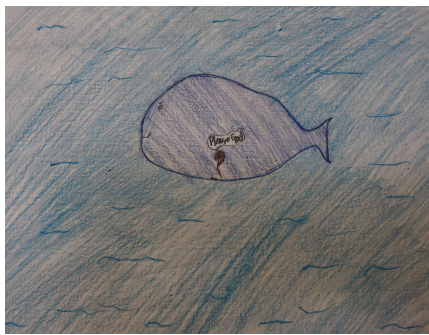
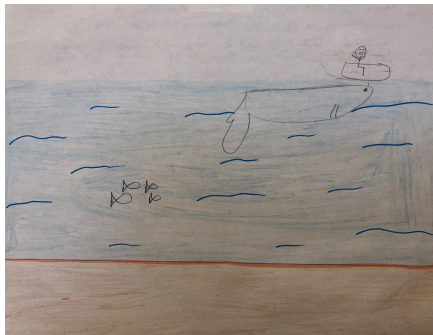
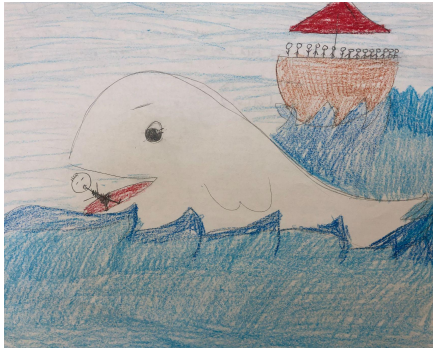
This week, our incredible Kindergarten students loved counting and writing in pictures. They also made Centurion helmets to go with the story of when Jesus healed the Centurion's servant!
