Jesus' Birth (3 People)	The Lord's Prayer	All of Them!

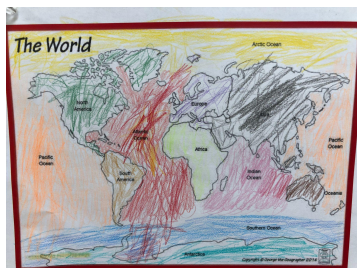
This week, our incredible Kindergarten students learned how to count to 8. They also learned about the 5 different oceans and the 7 different continents in geography class!
