Some of our favorite MAP testing snacks include: pretzels, muffins, Goldfish, cheese sticks, and peanut butter and jelly sticks.

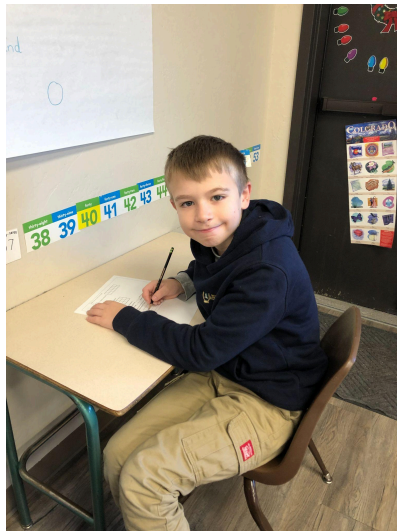
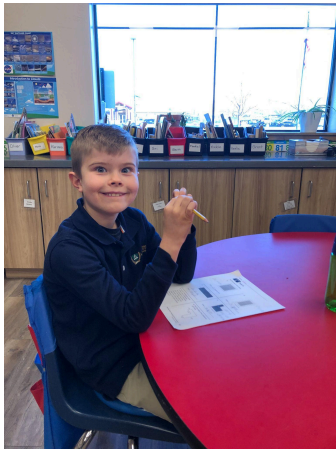
