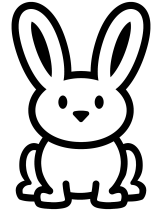

-What Did You Do For Spring Break-

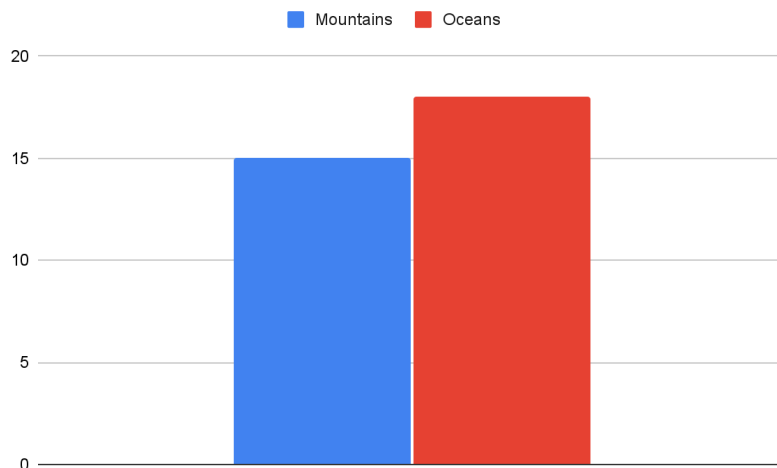

Some of our favorite flowers or trees include: sunflowers, roses, cherry blossoms, dog woods, redwoods, baby's-breath, tulips, and pine trees.

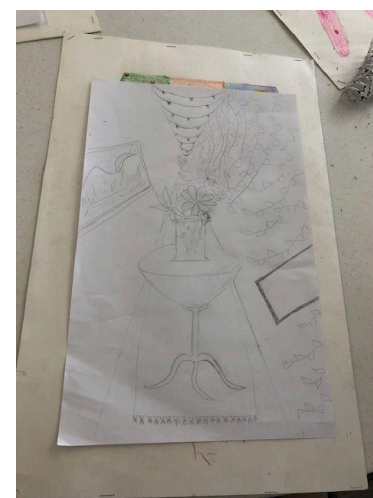
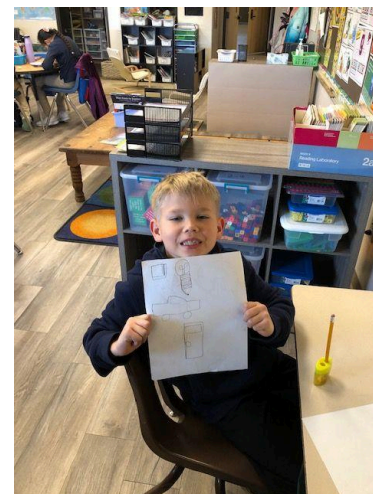
-Do You Like Mountains or Oceans More-
