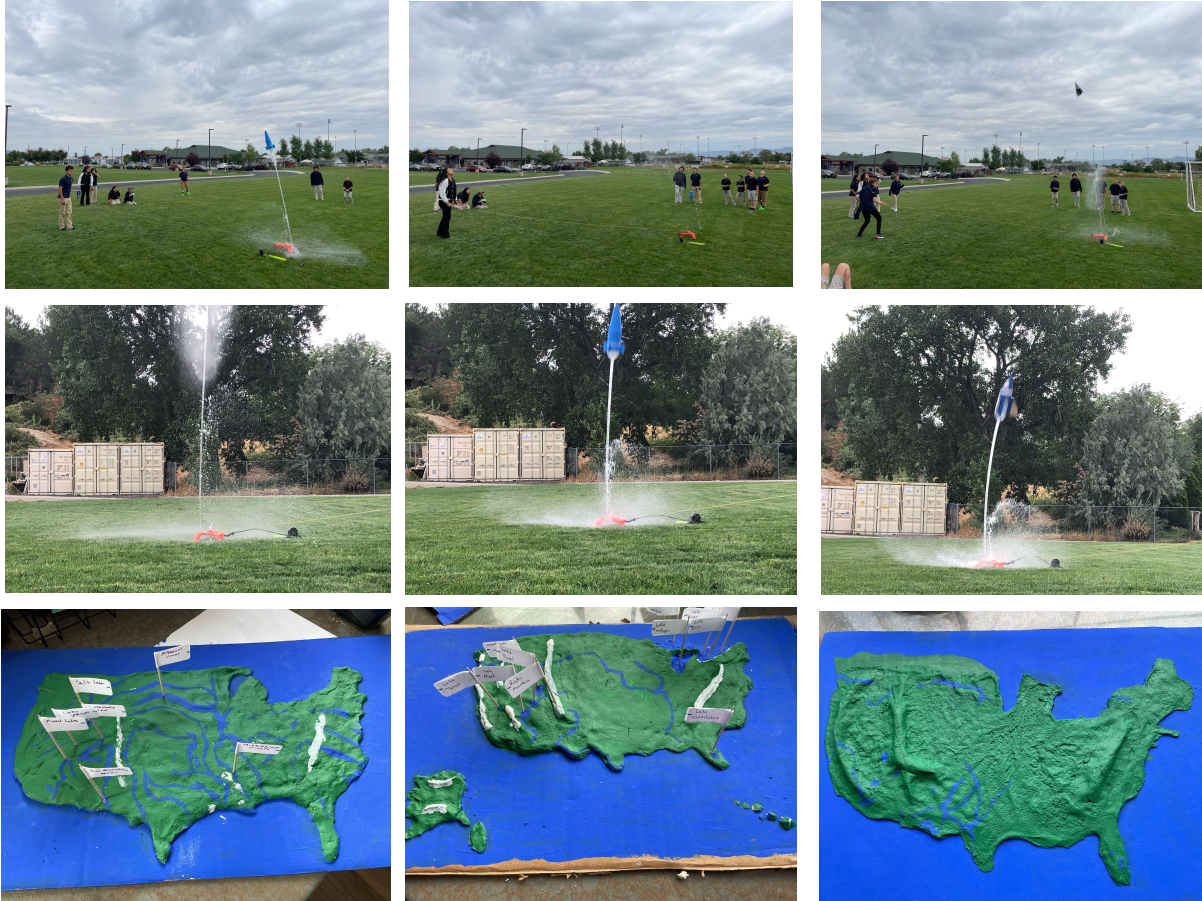
This week, our incredible Kindergarten students loved practicing counting to 5 and working on art projects!
