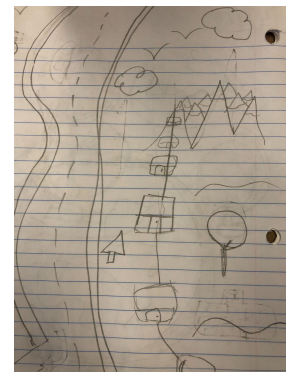
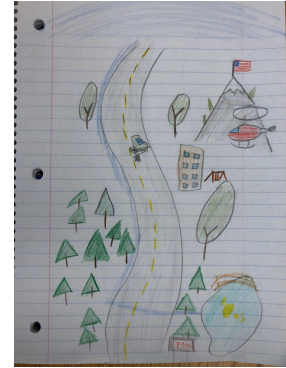
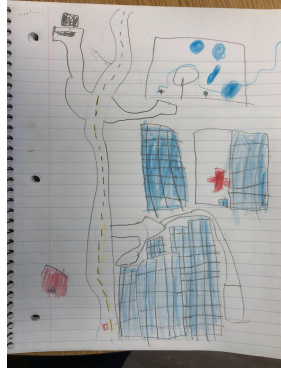
This week, our incredible Kindergarten students loved learning about Jesus and Social Studies. They also baked pretend cookies and finger painted.
